highly original voice.

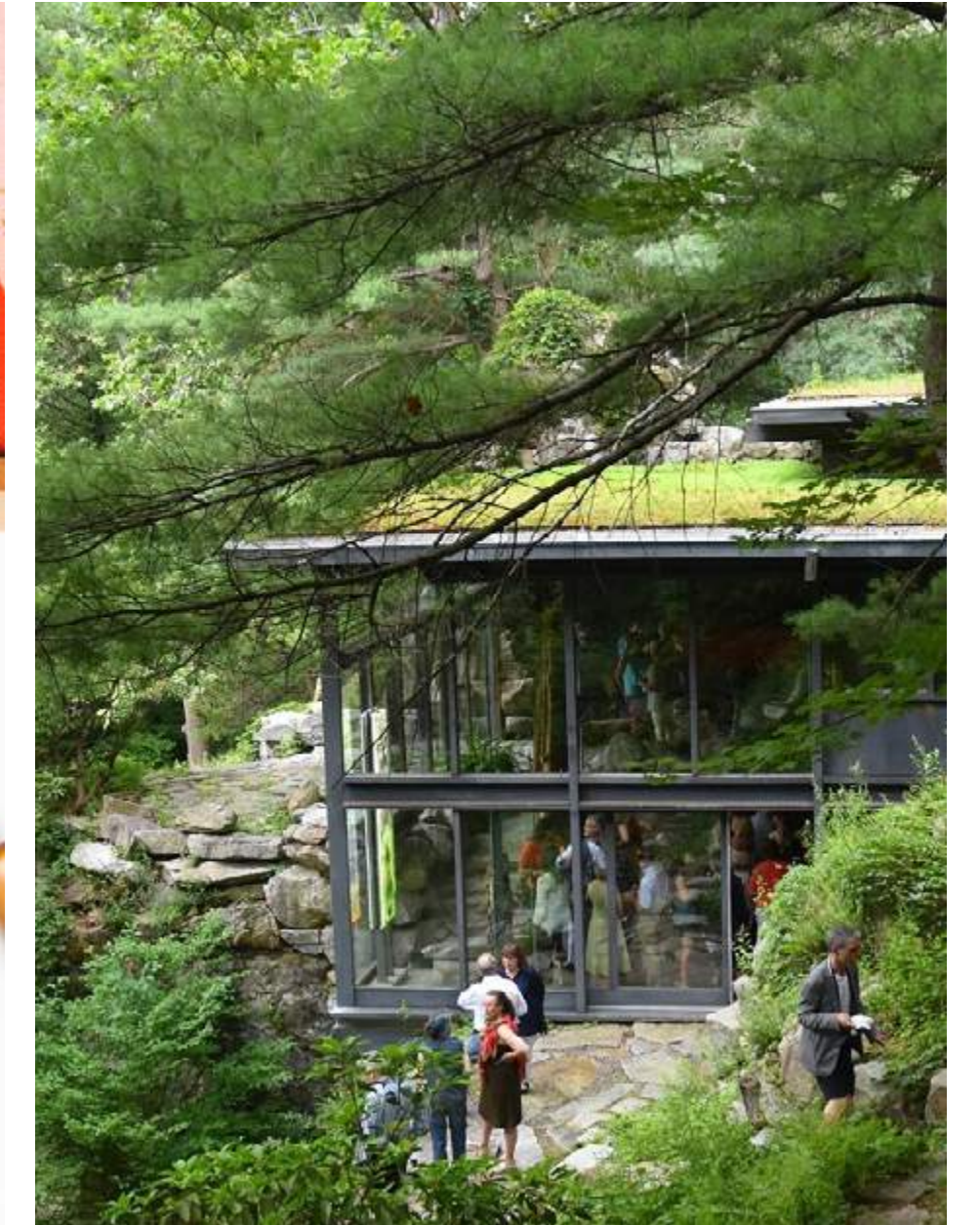
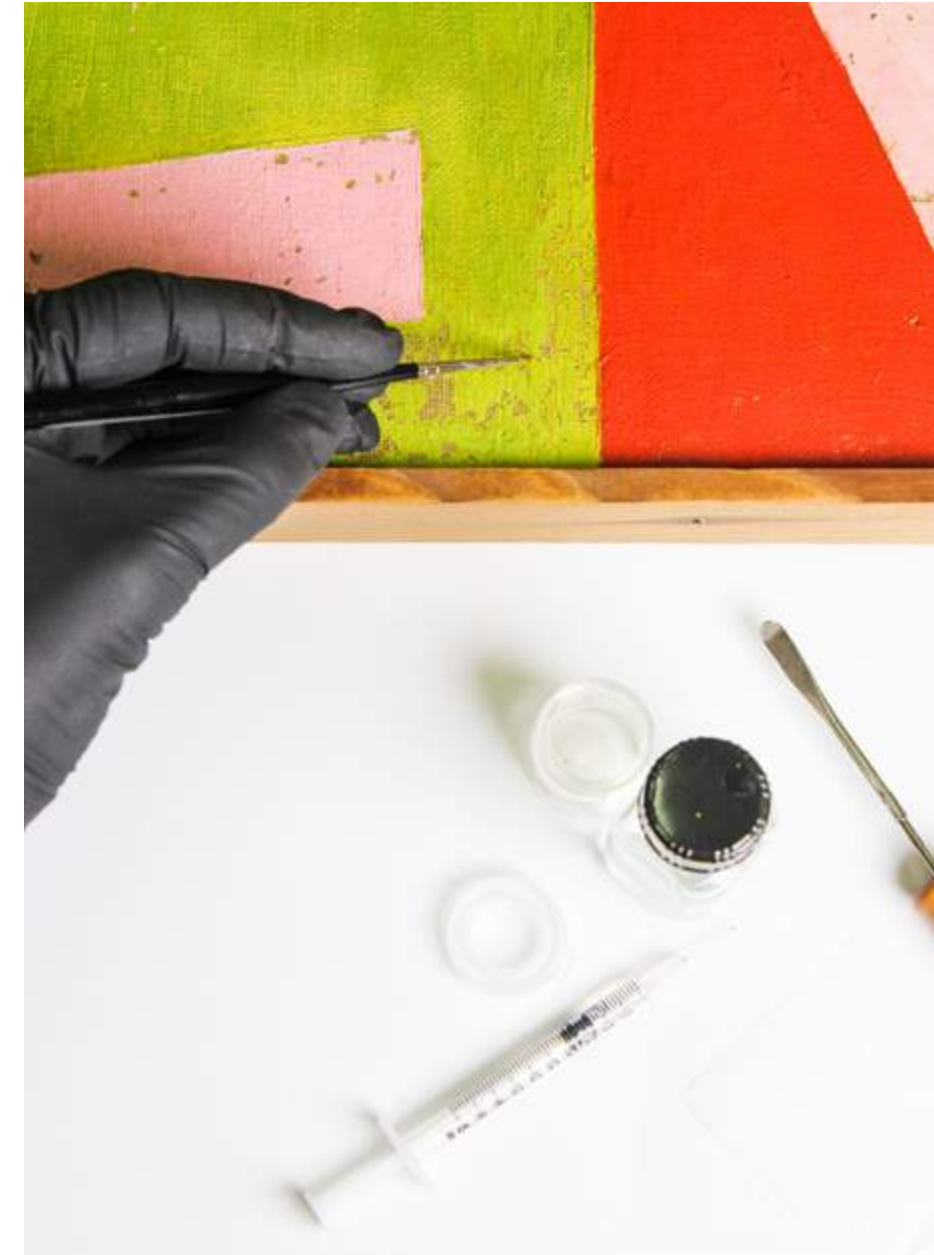

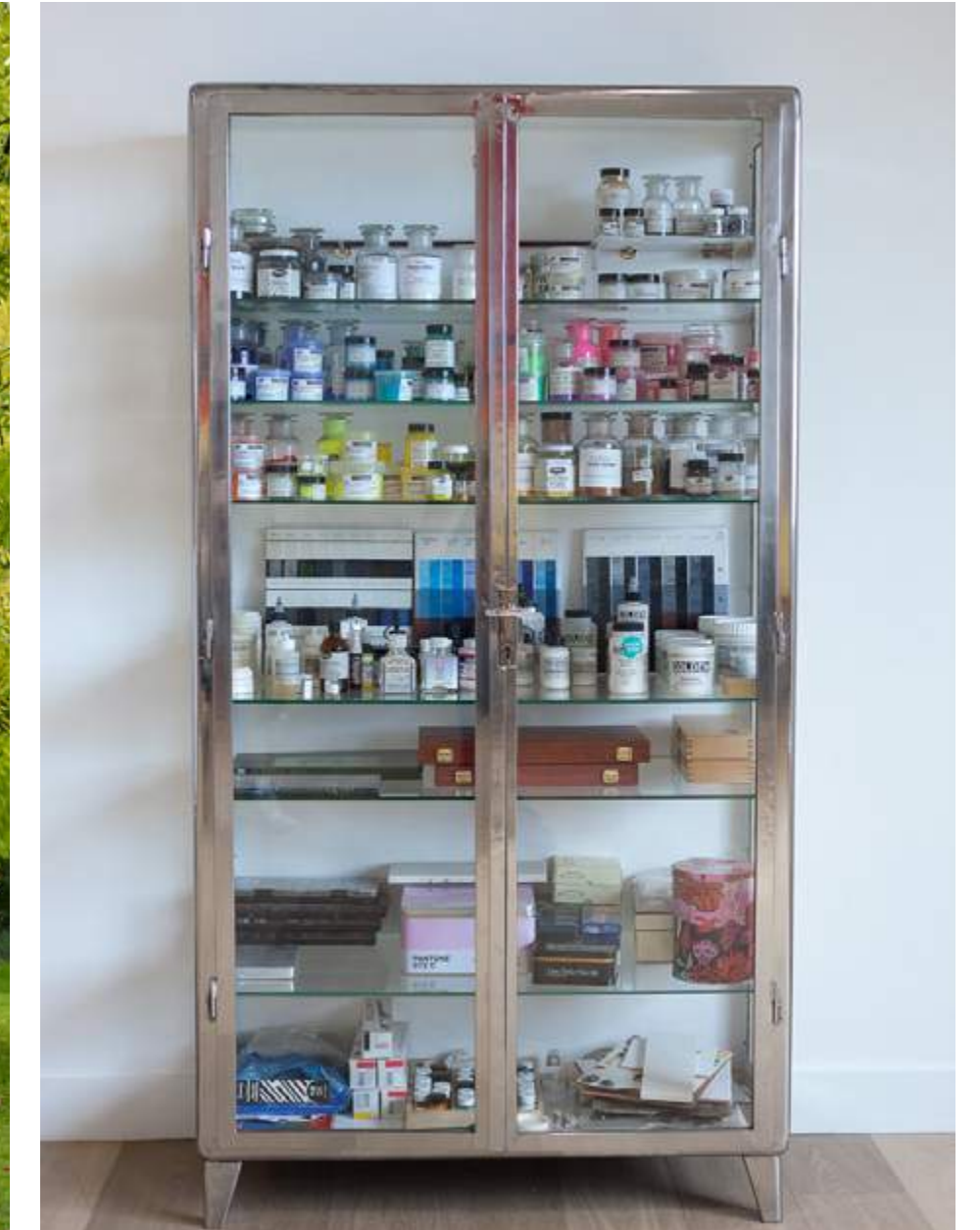
